Directions to the BBQ:

Starting from First Baptist Oviedo at 45 W Broadway St
Drive: 5.4 mi – about 14 mins

1. Head west on W Broadway St/SR-426 toward Red Bug Lake Road (1.9 mi)
2. Turn right at Red Bug Lake Rd (2.9 mi)
3. Turn right at Tuskawilla Rd (1.1 mi)
4. Turn left at E Lake Dr (1.1 mi)
Go around the curve, look for a street sign that says "Bird Road"
5. Turn right on Bird Rd then go about 1/4 mile further
6. After the gate entrance to Dunmar Estates, the next street is Via Capretti. Turn right here.
You'll see the lights at the barn once you are on this road for about 50 feet.

Special Guest Speaker: **Michelle Akers**

Akers was a three-time All-American from Shorecrest High School in Seattle. Akers then attended the University of Central Florida where she was a four-time All-American, was Central Florida's Athlete of the Year in 1988-89, the all-time leading scorer in UCF history, 1st woman to win the Hermann Trophy in 1988, and had her #10 jersey retired by the school. After graduation, she went to Sweden to play professional soccer, where she played three seasons for Tyresco Club - the first American women to play professional soccer.

Michelle was the most dominant player on the United States Women's National Team from 1985 until she retired in 2000. In 1999, she was named the FIFA Women's Player of the Century, as the top female soccer player in the world. In 2001, Michelle and her teammates from the 1991 Women's World Championship were awarded the Medal of Honor from the National Soccer Hall of Fame.
